Heat Map graphically illustrates, in a comparative format, data in four dimensions. Impact, Likelihood, Preparedness and Velocity

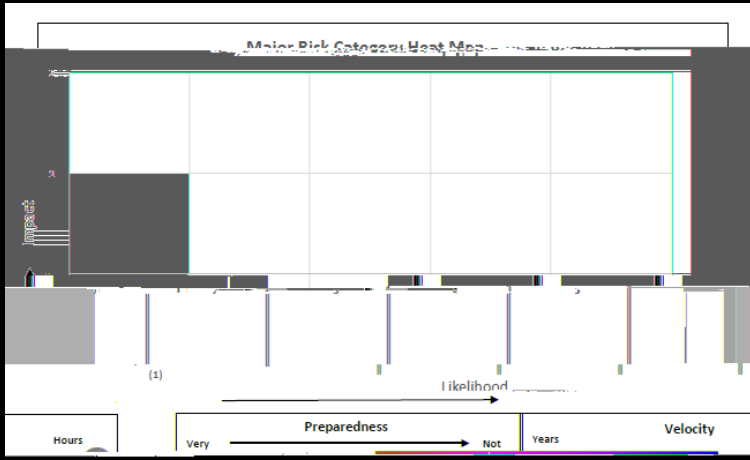

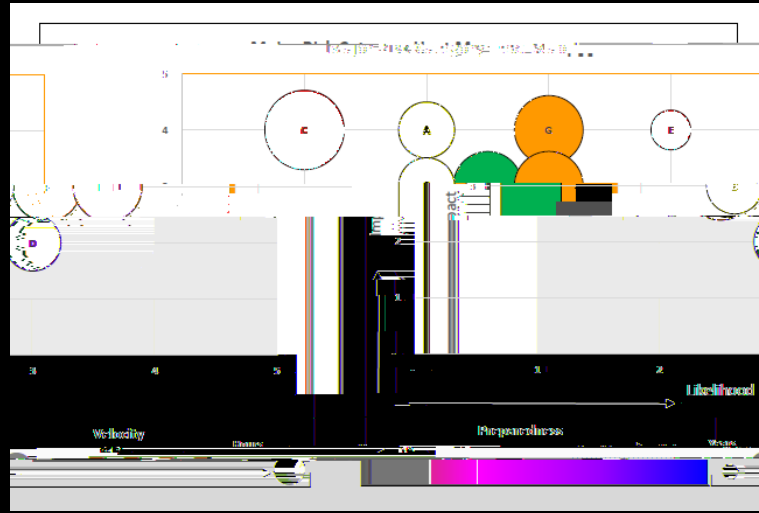
