05.02.1 ~~RB~~ ~~h~~ ~~h~~ . A role and responsibility assigned by law to the board is to set campus admission standards consistent with the role and mission of the institution. This responsibility of setting admission standards is delegated to the chancellor, or the chancellor's designee.

05.02.2 ~~Adm~~ Component institutions shall include admissions policies in their operating manuals or student handbooks. To ensure system excellence, the board shall promote enhanced recruitment strategies and the resource allocation necessary to ensure admission of a quality student body. Each component institution shall periodically present an admissions report to the board.

05.03 ~~Adm~~ The board delegates approval of degree requirements and conferral of degrees to the president of each component institution.

05.04 ~~Adm~~ ~~h~~ . An objective of the board is to ensure that each component institution's student financial aid programs provide assistance to students, who, without such assistance, may not be able to pursue higher education. Financial assistance at the component institutions may include, but is not limited to, loans, scholarships, grants, and employment. No student or prospective student shall be excluded from participation in or denied the benefits of any financial aid program at the component institution on the grounds of race, c ~~seace~~, c(i-0.004.1 (h)10 (e)0)0.8
